Based on its strategic position in pharmaceuticals, biotechnology, medical devices, telecommunications, homeland security and transportation, New Jersey is uniquely positioned to serve as a regional nucleus for the development and globalization of stem cell research, education and therapy.

**Community Development Roundtables** are facilitated discussions among people with diverse backgrounds who are interested in building goal-directed communities through collective intelligence and action. The purpose of these Roundtables is to collaboratively identify, develop and implement projects with positive social and/or economic impact. 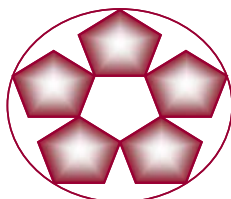
