2007 NJ Stem Cell Research Bond Act: What is it all about?

The Stem Cell Research Bond Act, upon approval by voters in November, authorizes the sale of State general obligation funds in the amount of \$450 million over 10 years. This forum aims to inform voters why this Act is on the ballot, the scientific research that this Act would support, the Act's potential benefits/pitfalls, how the money would be spent, and how it would be financed.
